

Purpose and Guidelines of the Missionary

PURPOSE OF MISSIONARY HOUSE

1. Housing for denominational missionaries while on stateside assignment. Missionaries would pay housing expenses plus a \$300 refundable deposit.
2. Housing for missionaries who have special needs (medical, evacuation from field of service, etc.) Missionaries would pay housing expenses plus a \$300.00 refundable deposit.
3. Vacation housing for missionaries on stateside assignment or vacation from field of service. Missionaries would pay \$50 per day - three days, minimum stay--plus a \$150.00 refundable deposit for housing expenses.
4. Temporary housing for pastors or staff of our association who have lost their jobs with no place to live (two months maximum stay). Those staying would pay housing expenses.
5. Temporary housing for pastors or staff who are transitioning to our association (two months maximum stay). Cost would be \$600 per month, plus housing expenses and a \$300 refundable deposit.
6. Special needs within our association as determined by the WBA and Missionary House Committee always giving priority to #1 and #2.

GUIDELINES FOR USE OF HOUSE

1. Priority use of the missionary house is for denominational missionaries related to the churches of our association (International Mission Board, Cooperative Baptist Fellowship).
2. Temporary housing for pastors transitioning to our association is restricted to participating and contributing churches of the Wilmington Baptist Association.
3. Housing expenses to be paid by missionary house residents include lights and water.
4. All parties using the missionary house are to leave the house clean and ready for use by the next occupants.
5. No pets!
6. Deposit is refundable when all housing cost and any damages to house have been paid.
7. Temporary use of missionary house (vacation, transitioning pastor, ect.) will be subject to cancellation, even when a date has been confirmed, in order to give priority to a missionary family for denominational stateside assignment or special needs.
